

Bridge Closure Checklist

ESF 3-1-1

Resource Needed

Duration less than One Hour

- Sheriff's Office – Traffic Control
- Henderson Police Department – Traffic Control
- Henderson Fire Department – Fire Suppression, Medical Response, Traffic Control, Patient Care
- Henderson Ambulance Service – Patient Care
- Wrecker – Next on the list + 2 (one for each side of the bridge to clear any secondary crashes/blockages)
- EMA – Coordination, resources, notifications
- Kentucky Transportation Cabinet – Traffic Management Assistance

Procedure – Law enforcement will setup traffic flow on unaffected bridge routing both NB & SB traffic lanes alternating every five minutes for the duration.

Radio Communications

- Using “Mutual Aid” Talk Group – Henderson Responders
- Using 8Tac91 – Vanderburgh County / Evansville Responders

Duration One to three Hours

- Sheriff's Office – Traffic Control
- Henderson Police Department – Traffic Control
- Kentucky State Police – Traffic Control
- Evansville Police Department – Traffic Control (EVV side)***
- Vanderburgh County Sheriff's Office – Traffic Control (EVV Side)***
- Indiana State Police (EVV Side)***
- Henderson Fire Department – Fire Suppression, Medical Response, Traffic Control, Patient Care
- Henderson Ambulance Service – Patient Care
- Wrecker – Next on the list x2 (one for each side of the bridge to clear any secondary crashes/blockages)
- EMA – Coordination, Resources, notifications – (consider mobile command roll-out)
 - County Vol Fire Departments
 - County First responders

- Henderson City/County Rescue Squad
- Kentucky Transportation – Cones, Message Boards, Flip Signs

Procedure - Law enforcement will setup traffic flow on unaffected bridge routing both NB & SB traffic lanes alternating every five minutes for the duration.

- Using 8Tac91 – Vanderburgh County / Evansville Responders

Duration Greater than Three Hours

- Sheriff’s Office – Traffic Control
- Henderson Police Department – Traffic Control
- Kentucky State Police
- *Evansville Police Department – Traffic Control (EVV side) ***
- *Vanderburgh County Sheriff’s Office – Traffic Control (EVV Side) ***
- *Indiana State Police (EVV Side) ***
- Henderson Fire Department – Fire Suppression, Medical Response, Traffic Control, Patient Care
- Henderson Ambulance Service – Patient Care
- Wrecker – Next on the list x2 (one for each side of the bridge to clear any secondary crashes/blockages)
- EMA – Coordination (consider mobile command roll-out / EOC Activation)
 - County Vol Fire Departments
 - County First responders
 - Henderson City / County Rescue Squad
- Kentucky Transportation – Traffic Management

Procedure - Law enforcement will setup traffic flow on unaffected bridge routing both NB & SB traffic lanes over the bridge alternating every five minutes for the duration. If necessary, Law Enforcement will also detour northbound traffic east across the Audubon Parkway as necessary with assistance by KYTC.
